The golden-yellow colored 2019 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc opens intense and chalky on the concentrated and refreshing nose that reveals lemon zest notes intertwined with notes of crushed stones. Round, lush and intense on the palate, this is a rich, full-bodied and sustainable blend of Grenache Gris and Grenache Blanc with Macabeo. Aged for one year in smaller barrels, this mouth-filling and hedonistic wine reveals spectacular finesse and elegance with fine tannins and a persistent mineral structure. A superb white from Calce. Natural cork. 13% stated alcohol. Tasted in Oldenburg, Germany, in February 2022.

The 2019 Domaine de l'Horizon Rouge offers an alluring bouquet of perfectly ripe sloes, cherries, blue berries and blackcurrant. Filigreed, refined and terribly fresh on the palate, this is a gorgeous, lush and intense but medium-weight red with fine tannins and vibrant mineral acidity that is sourced in slate (Grenache) and limestone (Carignan). A fabulous, pure and aromatic wine with serious substance. Natural cork. 12.5% stated alcohol. Tasted in Oldenburg, Germany, in February 2022.

Full-bodied, lush and generous but refined, fresh and elegant on the palate, this is a firmly structured but perfectly ripe and tensioned red wine based in Carignan and Grenache Noir. The 2016 Domaine de l'Horizon Rouge is deep, intense, lush and plummy on the nose that also reveals finely grained stony notes of potted strawberry, raspberry, nougat and mocha. Full-bodied, intense and generous on the palate but fresh and vital, with fine tannins and mineral acidity, this is a big and tensioned, typically Catalan red wine with plummy rather than forest berry aromas and a great finish, very long, pure and tensioned. Full-bodied, lush and tight but also refined and elegant on the palate, this is a complex and tensioned, potent and persistent assemblage of Grenache Blanc, Grenache Gris and Macabeo that is structured by fine, ripe tannins and a coolish, elegant and salty finish. The 2013 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc shows a deep, pure, refined and flinty yet also intense and aromatic nose with ripe and concentrated fruit aromas. On the palate, this is a tight, dense and concentrated but also vital and vibrantly fresh Horizon with only a hint of maturity in the flavors but with mineral complexity, grip and length. The orange-colored 2008 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc is pure, refined and delicately oxidative on the nose, but it doesn't lack any precision, spices or even concentration. Full-bodied, intense and rich on the palate but elegant, precise and fresh, with linear, ripe acidity, remarkable extract and fine tannins, this wine is stylistically unique, which I also found attractive in its youth. Though I never expected this orange color of this formerly intensely lemon-colored wine, but the precision, vitality, intensity and extract are still untouched. The very first but never released vintage of the domaine is the 2006 Domaine de l'Horizon Blanc, of which 1,600 liters were produced for a wedding party (on the press from Gérard Gauby and in the vats from Tom Lubbe). It's a golden-orange colored white with great chalky and slatey precision and fine reduction but also pretty toasty notes. Fullbodied, massive and concentrated on the palate, with astringent tannins, this is a massive but still vital white from the south, with lots of alcohol, warmth and intensity but also precision and even finesse.
